We are recruiting for seasonal staff to work with us over our spring and summer camps. We have part-time weekend positions for spring, and full-time roles during the summer, working as an Activity Leader or a Summer Cara. Main Responsibilities include:

- Reporting into the Camp Management Team, you will assist with the planning and leading of designated activities that are safe, fun and engaging for campers.

During children only camps, additional responsibilities include;

- Providing overnight support and supervision for our campers in their cottage accommodation on a rostered basis.
